### Notification / Appointment Mamarine (Burials at Sea.co.uk)

From being notified of the death (usually from the Funeral Directors) we take full responsibility for obtaining the MMO licence through our MMO online account.



By appointing Mamarine (Burials at Sea.co.uk) to carry out the operational part of a burial at sea we can now start the process of obtaining an MMO Burial at sea licence or for John O'Groats Marine Scotland we require copies of the following documents :

**The Death Certificate  
Freedom from Fever and Certificate Infection  
Coroners Out of England Certificate (Form 103)**



Following receipt of these 3 documents the online process of obtaining MMO /Marine Scotland licence. At this stage we only need email copies of the documents - originals will be required and available on the day of the burial at sea for MMO inspection

### Successful Licence Application — Communication /Operational logistics

We now start checking the weather forecasts liaising with the family /funeral directors to establish a likely burial date. Once the date has been agreed we can put in place the logistical aspects of the day

We will also seek to establish how many family/friend will wish to accompany the deceased on their final journey aboard our cruiser (up to 10 passenger plus the deceased). Additional passenger capacity is available via added vessels being chartered in as support.

**Our home designated area in The Needles –we can arrange other designated sites**

**ENGLAND'S licensing organisation is MMO (Marine Management Organisation)**

**SCOTLAND- Marine Scotland are the licensing organisation**

#### Burials at Sea - Designated Areas

Owners/masters/charterers/nominees of fishing vessels are reminded that there are two Scottish sites designated for burials at sea. It is therefore recommended that fishing activity at these sites be avoided.

Designated Area	Co-Ordinates
(A) 210 miles due west of Oban	56° 45'N 009° 15'W
(B) 15 miles west of John O'Groats	58° 42.70'N 003° 23.30'W



We use a crane to lift the casket aboard our vessel at Berthons shipyard\* – prior to meeting the family at the Lyminster Harbour Masters Pontoon – casket Flagged



### **MAMARINE (BURIALS AT SEA.CO.UK ) – DELIVERY OF THE BURIAL AT SEA**

We assume full responsibility for carrying out MMO Licence requirements once the casket has been placed aboard our chosen vessel. We will charter sufficient vessels to deal with any additional passengers wishing to accompany their loved one on this final journey.
